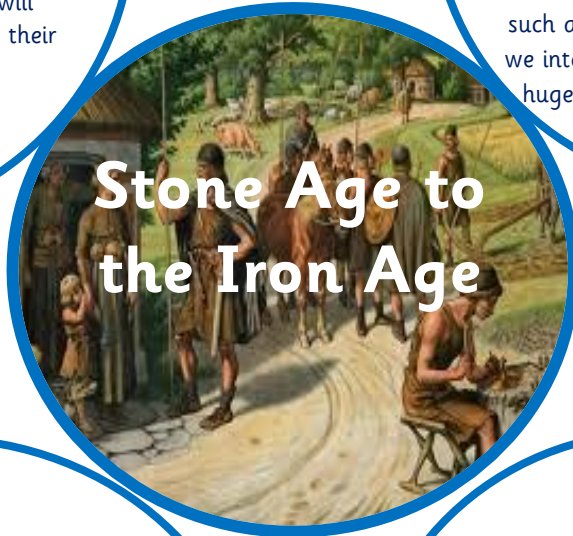
Art

Monochromatic

In this drawing unit, children will learn how artists create perspective, how they use line, shape, and value to create a sense of form, and about different shading techniques. They will learn from the work of great painters, modern artists, and collagists. They will develop their ability to evaluate their own work, and they will become more confident while creating their own more divergent outcomes.

History

In this unit, children learn about prehistory in Britain, and how we find out about prehistory. They discover what life was like through each of the main time periods of the Stone Age, right through to the Iron Age. Children find out about how civilisation started, how agriculture became a huge driving force for things like stone circles to be built and how different metals such as bronze and iron changed the way we interacted with each other and created huge defensive earthworks that we can even see and walk today.

Christianity – What kind of world did Jesus want?

In this unit, pupils will learn about the concept of 'Gospel', the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus. Pupils will find out about Jesus' actions towards other people and what example these set for the actions of Christians today. Pupils will learn about links between the teachings within Bible and what the meaning of Jesus' good news for Christians is.

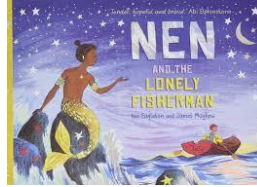

Computing

Pupils will learn to recognise inputs and outputs and that a computer sends and receives information. They will explore the parts of a laptop and how they work together - identifying their purpose. Finally, they will explain what an algorithm is and learn to programme them.

Science

Animals including humans

How do the systems inside our body work to make a healthy human?

During this unit of work, children will learn about the structure of the human skeleton and how the muscles work alongside the skeleton to support and protect the human body. They will then look at how skeletons differ in different animals. Finally, children will look at nutrition and the importance of eating a healthy diet.



PSHRE

Pupils will learn that families vary, differences must be respected and how to solve relationship problems. During health and wellbeing, pupils will learn about physical and mental health. Through citizenship, the pupils will understand about human rights and children's rights. Economic wellbeing introduces pupils to budgeting and looking after money. Safety and the changing body will look at how to stay safe online and around real-life situations, as well as the changing body (Y4).

French

Year 3 - Introduction to French culture
Greetings, names, numbers to 10, classroom instructions
Year 4 – Pets, At home, school subjects, sports and hobbies, instruments and weather.

Music

Pupils will explore the features of a ballad, performing using actions and learning to sing in time. Using their new learning, pupils will retell an animations story, write their own verse (including rhyming words) and perform the lyrics fluently.
